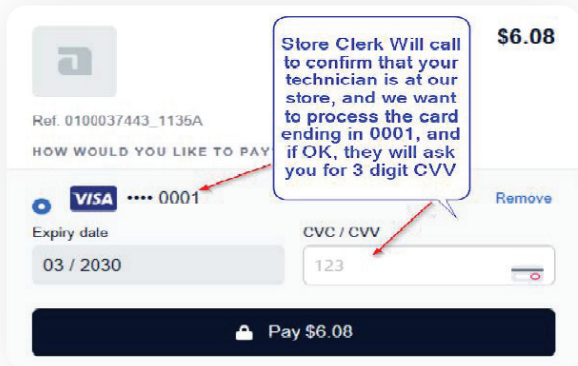




What is Tokenization?

Tokenization is the process of replacing sensitive data with non-sensitive data. It's used in the payment industry to safeguard a card's primary account number (PAN) by replacing it with a unique string of numbers.

- 1) Our credit card processing partner, 'ADYEN,' enables us to provide Tokenization to our customers, expediting the checkout process when a card isn't physically present. We will only tokenize a card if this form is signed and on file with our company. First-time users are required to provide the complete card number, expiration date, and CVV over the phone.
2) Store personnel will only see the last 4-digits of your tokenized card.
3) Store personnel will always call the employer to confirm the use of the card.
4) Store personnel will call for the 3- or 4-digit CVV code and confirm the name on the card.
5) Do not write your CVV number on this form.
